Overview

The conferences organized by the Greek Association of Computational Mechanics (GRACM) every three years are meeting points of the Greek computational mechanics community, both the domestic and that of the diaspora, along with international participation. Besides established areas of computational mechanics, the 7th GRACM Conference will emphasize on new and interdisciplinary ones, such as multiscale modeling and simulation, mechanics in the life sciences and computational materials science. A primary goal of the Conference is to attract young researchers; dedicated sessions are planned and reduced conference fees are in place for that purpose.
